4. pays the Annual Subscription of £2 per person – Membership will run from 1<sup>st</sup> May.

1. are showing your commitment and support towards the Village Hall and Recreation Ground facilities in the Village; and
2. can vote at the Annual and General Meetings of the CIO at which important business concerning the Charity Trustees and finances are decided.
